The Resilience Education to Advance Community Healing Statewide Initiative (REACH) was launched in 2020 in partnership with the Center for Childhood Resilience (CCR) at Ann and Robert H. Lurie Children's Hospital. In partnership with REACH, Resilience-Supportive Schools Illinois (RSSI) was developed as a statewide initiative to provide schools with a data-driven approach to student mental health. RSSI empowers educators with insights and resources to create safer, more supportive learning environments.

The Challenge

Illinois schools faced a critical challenge in supporting student mental health—data on well-being and social-emotional learning was scattered across multiple surveys and reports, making it difficult for educators to identify trends and take meaningful action.

The Approach


The Lurie's/RSSI team partnered with LaunchPad Lab to build a scalable, educator-focused platform. An eight-week Blueprint Workshop shaped the solution through stakeholder interviews, wireframes, and technical planning. The final platform integrates data dashboards, professional learning, and a guided user experience.
